Hello,

LéOparleur is an 8-person crew.

We need 1 double room and 3 twins in a comfortable hotel
**minimum close to the venue and 8 breakfasts

Upon their arrival, the band likes to have salads, cheese, chicken... as well as tea, coffee, beer and fruit juice.

According to the show time we will have our meal before or after the concert. We like to have 1st and 2nd courses, desert, coffee and wine.

Please take into account that two members of the band are veggies. Please avoid pork in general. Fish and beef as well as local specialties are welcome.

In the dressing room before the concert, we need a bottle of Havana Club, 25 beers -good quality, 2 bottles of good wine and 10 1.5-litre bottles of water.

For the show we need **one bottle of Pastis 1.5L** (Pernod or Ricard are OK) and 100 transparent plastic cups and 2 bottles of water, 1.5L

For venues with capacity superior to 500 people, please double these quantities.

We also need 12 small bottles of water (0.5L) and 5 towels.

Please provide a place where we can sell t-shirts and CD's with a table and chairs and the possibility to hang shirts.

We need 2 hours before the soundcheck to set up the lighting equipment and the backline on stage. The soundcheck lasts one hour and a half.

In case you could not comply, please contact us, we always find a solution.

We provide one in ear monitor HF

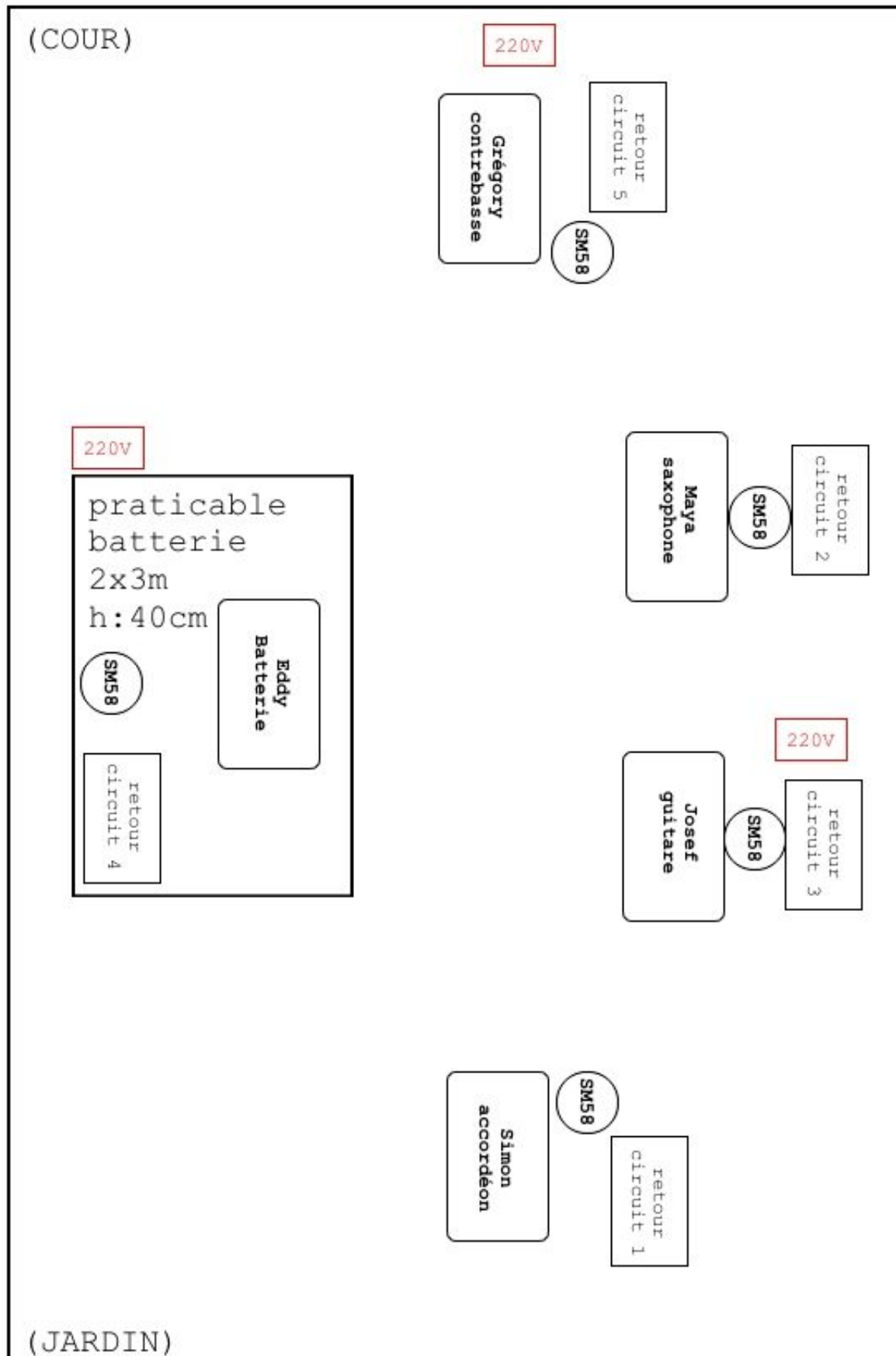

- **Stage** : covered, minimum size : 10 x 6 m, 1 m high.
- **PA** : adapted to the size of the venue, 3/4 active channels + subwoofers. For greater venues, please set up delayed speakers if necessary. Préférences : Adamson, L-Acoustics.
- **Main console** : 40 channels with 4-band parametric eq's, sweepable low-cut, 8 aux, 8 groups, VCAs are welcome...
Preferred models : Midas XL, Héritage, Yamaha PM 4000, PM 3500, DM2000 (please let us know...) , Soundcraft MH4, MH3.
Please avoid Spirit, Mackie etc...
- **Sound processors**: 1 stereo EQ type : DN360 Klark Teknik, GQ600 XTA or FCS960 BSS. **Please no 2031 Yamaha.**
1 Delay with **tap tempo** type : TC2290, DTWO, please no Roland SDE
1 SPX 990
1 reverb type : TC M2000, M5000, Lexicon PCM
8 compression channels type : DBX 166, BSS DPR 402/404
4 gate channels if not included with the compressors
type : DS201, DPR504
Please avoid Behringer sound processors.
1 CD player.
- **Monitor mixer** : 24 channels with parametric eq, 8 aux pre/post **minimum**. Preferences : Midas XL, Yamaha PM, Soundcraft SM
- **Monitors** : 8 identical wedges type : PS15 Nexo, MTD115 L-Acoustics including one at the monitoring console.
For stages wider than 12m, please add two equalized side-fills, thanks.
5 EQ channels type : DN360 Klark Teknik, GQ600 XTA or FCS960 BSS. **No 2031 Yamaha, thanks.**
